## MISREPRESENTATION OF IWH MEMBERSHIP CERTIFICATES

Members of the industry are hereby informed that certain companies are falsifying IWH membership certificates to create the impression that they are members of the Institute for Work at Height. This in an apparent attempt to gain access to tenders or contracts. The certificate shown below is a classic example of such a case reported to us in the last few days.

### CERTIFICATE ISSUES

- THE NAME ON THE CERTIFICATE (NOW REDACTED) IS NOT NOW AND NEVER HAS BEEN A MEMBER OF THE IWH
- COMPANY REGISTRATION NUMBER SHOWN BELONGS TO A DIFFERENT ORGANISATION THAT IS A LEGITIMATE MEMBER
- THE UNIQUE ID CODE BELONGS TO THE LEGITIMATE MEMBER COMPANY
- THE CERTIFICATE NUMBER HAS BEEN ALTERED
